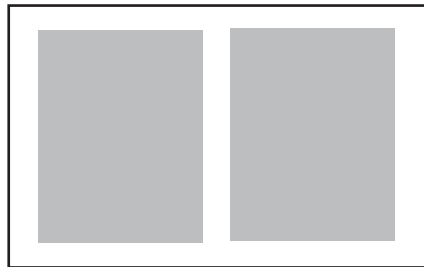
PRINTING TIPS

1) Our files are in US-letter format. Please make sure you select the option «scale» or «fit» in your printer settings.

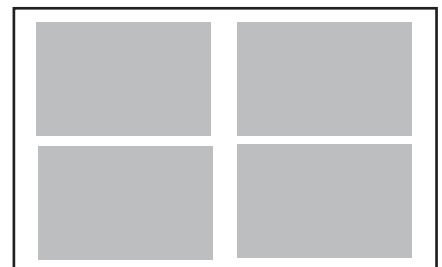
2) **NEW LAYOUT! To offer more printing flexibility to you**, we have purposely designed this book with 1 page of the story per PDF page (our old layout was 2 pages of the story per PDF page). This allows you to choose to print the book as it (a PDF page per page of paper sheet) or to select in your printer settings the number of PDF pages you want to print per page of paper sheet (to get smaller sizes. size depending on how many pages you choose per sheet).

when selecting to print 2 PDF pages per page of paper sheet



when selecting to print 4 PDF pages per page of paper sheet

etc.

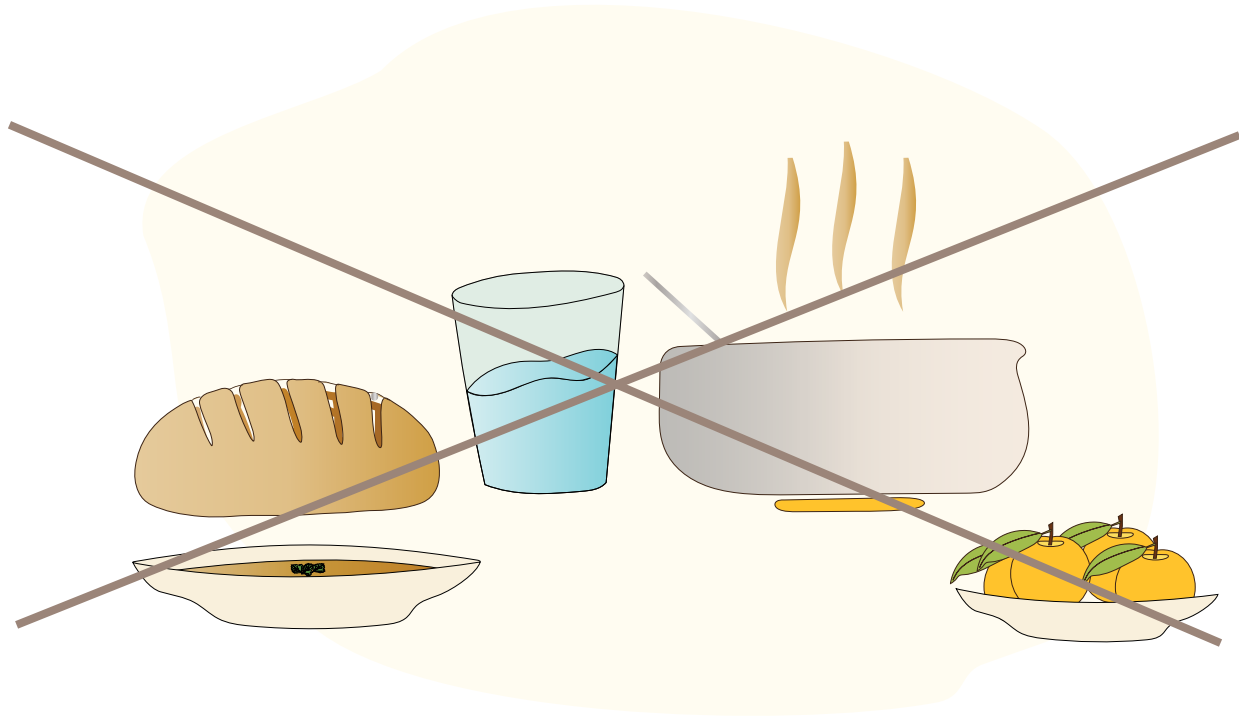

During Ramadan, the fasting persons don't eat and don't drink from dawn to sunset.

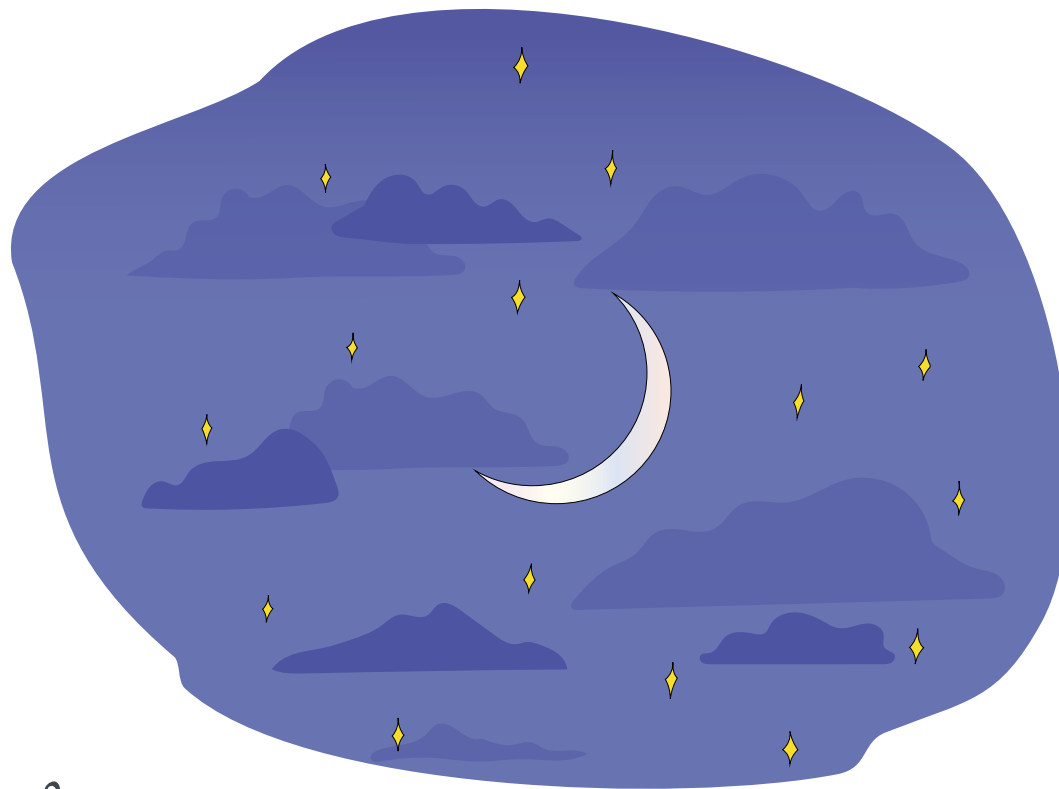

The month of Ramadān has arrived!

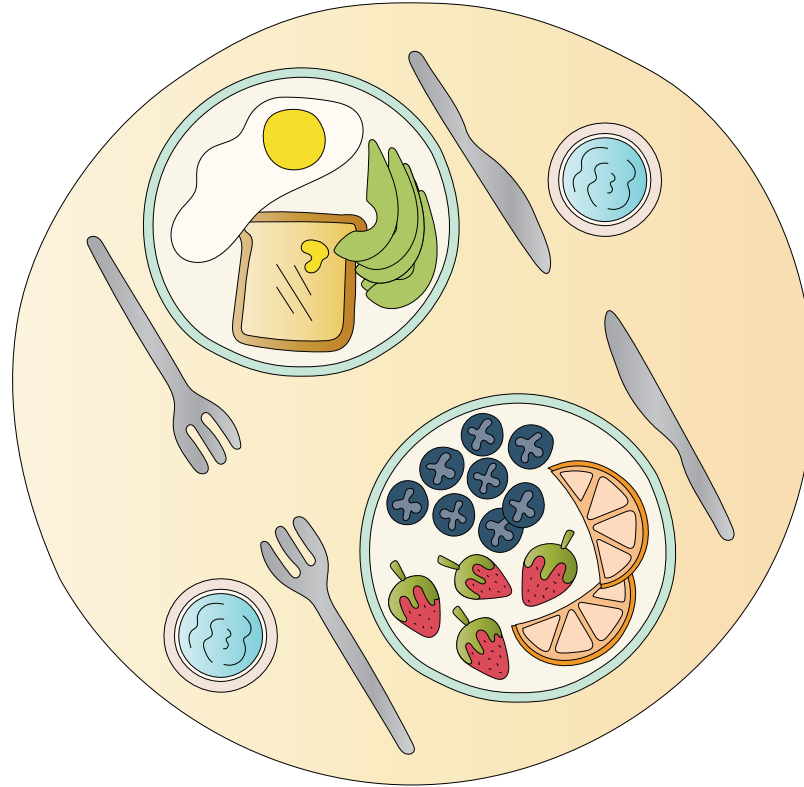


فِي السَّمَاءِ هَيْلَالٌ وَاحِدٌ.

The time of **suhoor** (pre-dawn meal) is before dawn.

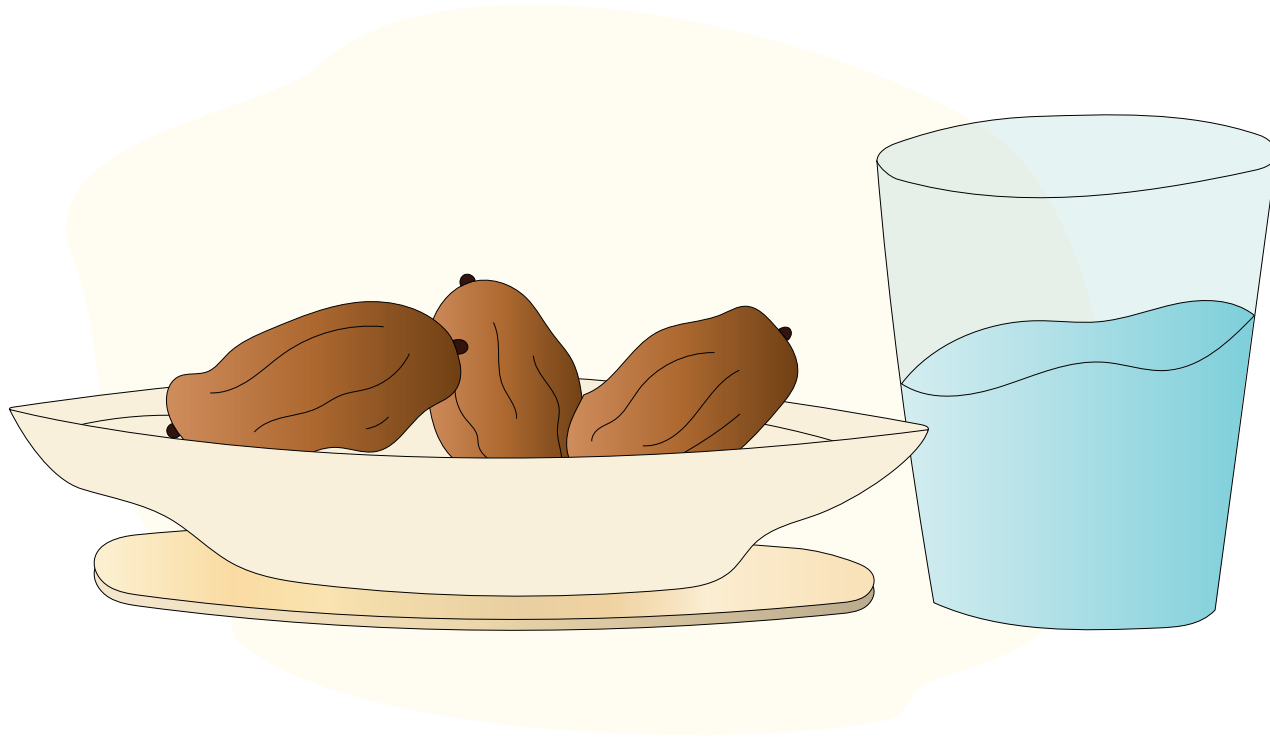


عَلَى الطَّاوِلَةِ طَبَقَانِ طَيِّبَانِ.

The sun has set, this is the time of **iftar** (breaking the fast)!

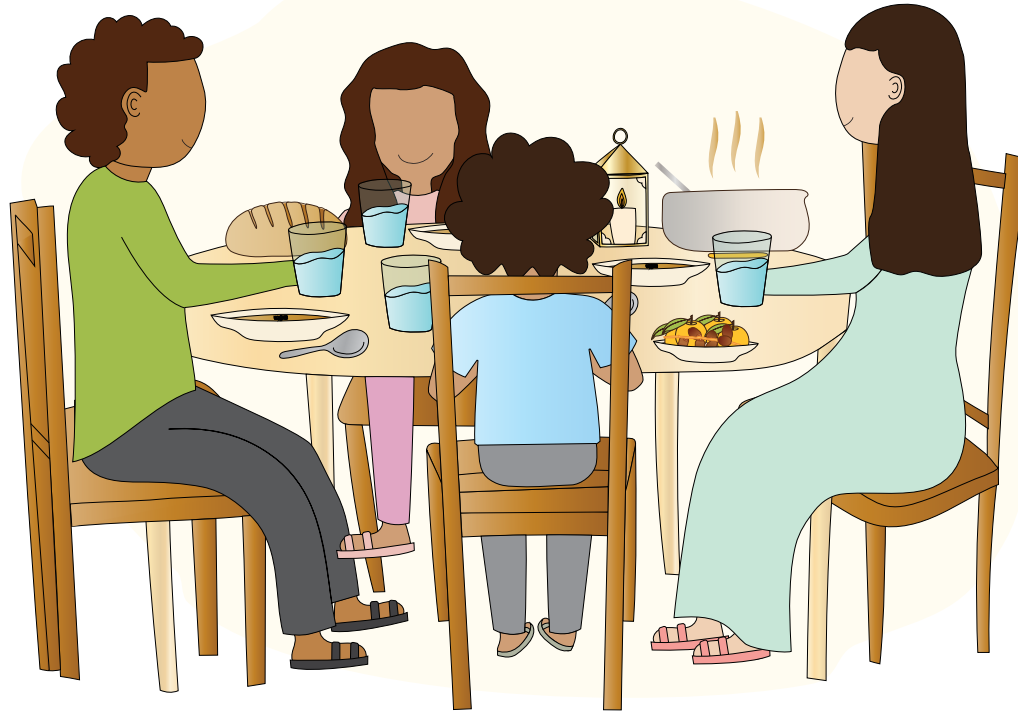


فِي الصَّحْنِ ثَلَاثُ تَمْرَاتٍ.

This family is having iftar (fast-breaking meal).

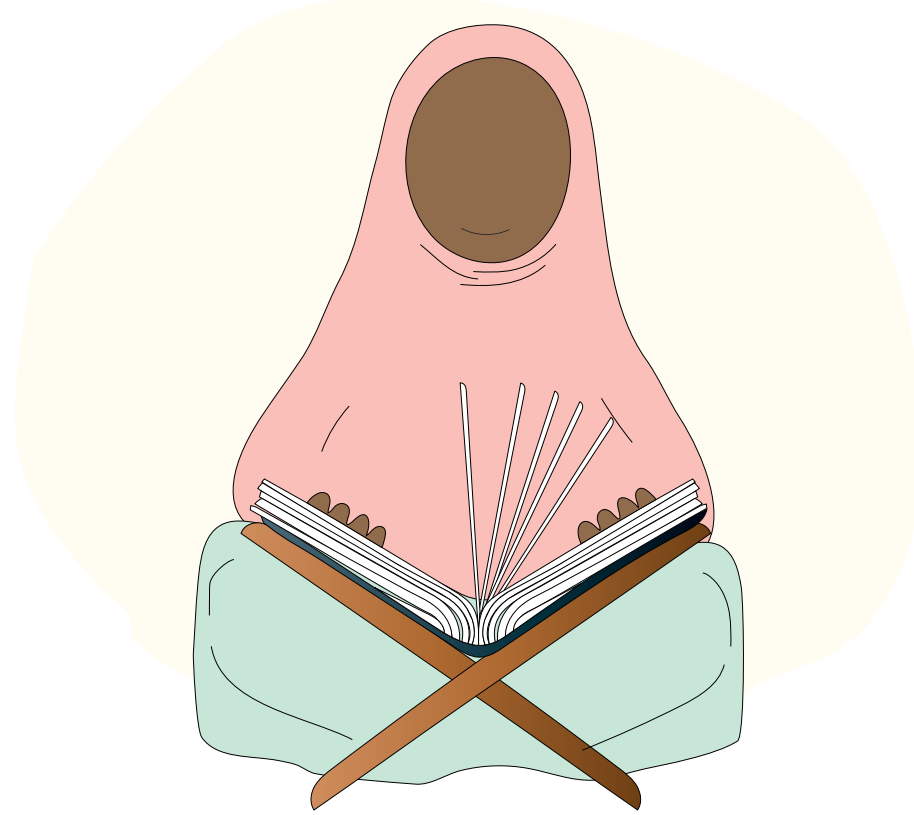


عَلَى مَائِدَةِ الْإِفْطَارِ أَرْبَعَةٌ أَكْوَابٍ.

This woman has read 5 pages.

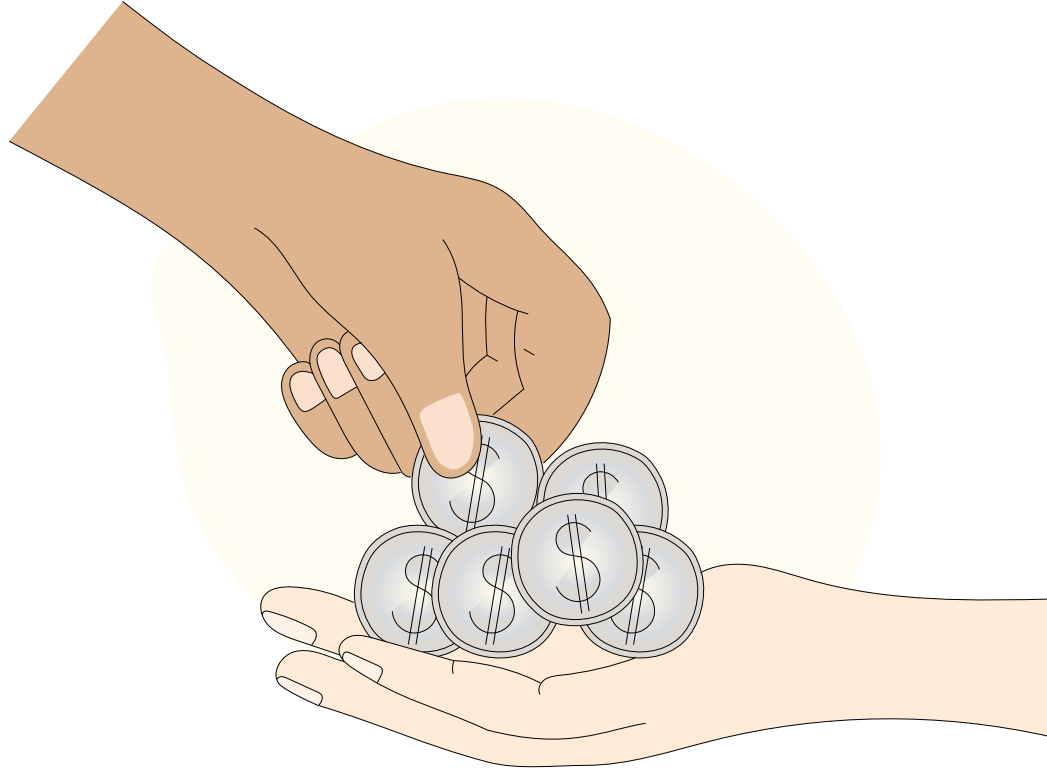

Muslims multiply charitable donations during Ramadan.

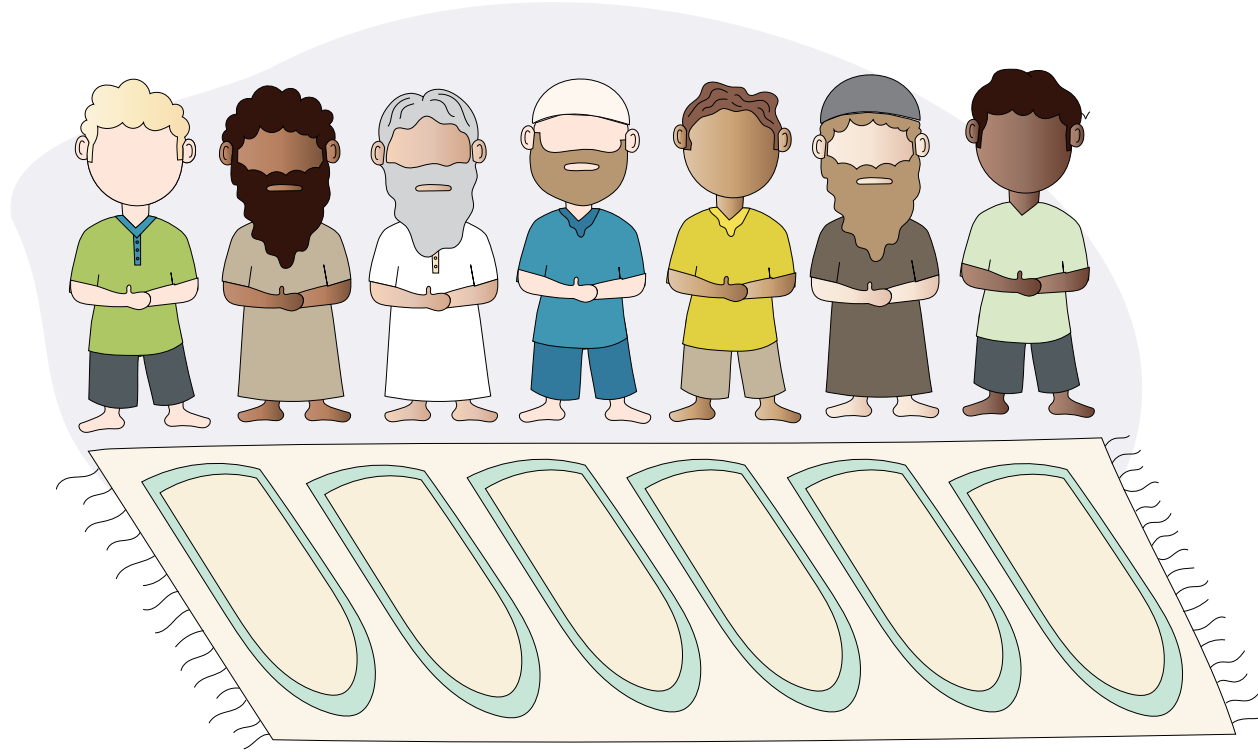


فِي الْيَدِ سِتَّةُ قُرُوشٍ.

7 men are standing in row for the Taraweeh prayer.

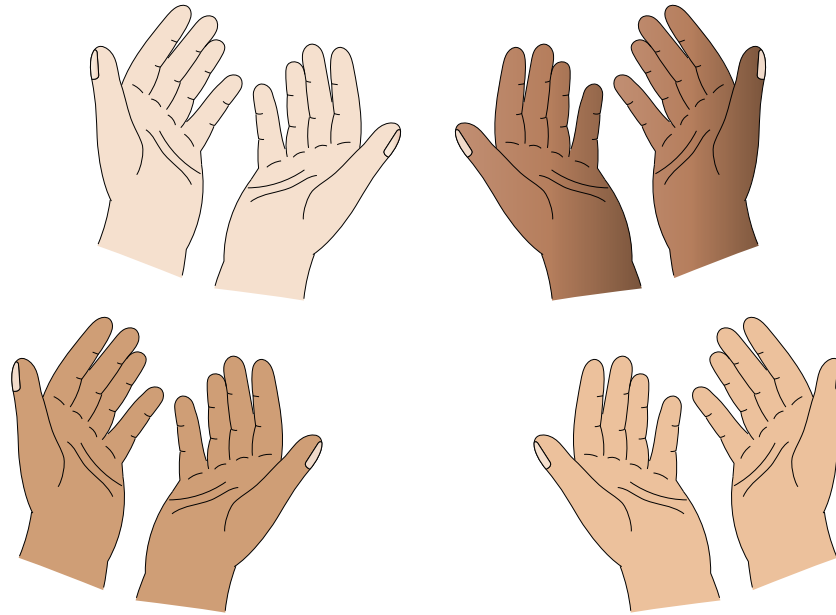

In the last ten days, muslims seek Laylatul-Qadr (the Night of Decree).

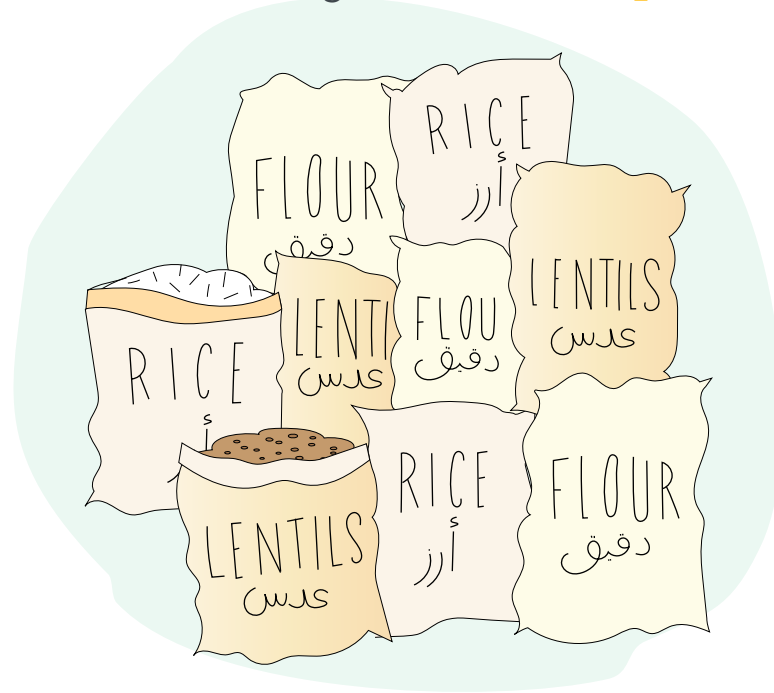



ثَمَانِيَةٌ أَيْدٍ مَّرْتَفِعَةٌ بِالذُّعَاءِ.
