English Commands (verbs in the imperative form or short sentences)	Arabic Infinitive Verbs (to search in the online conjugator)	Arabic Commands - with "YOU" singular, masculine (for other personal pronoun, check out our online conjugator tutorial)
Read	قرأ	اقرأ
Say	قال	قل
Be gentle/kind	كان لطيفاً (in the conjugator, only search:) كان	كن لطيفاً ***

*** when conjugating, don't forget to change لطيفاً too! Example for a girl, you'll say:
كوني لطيفةً. *This is also true for the following commands with the same structure.*

Walk	مشي	امش
Stand up	وقف	قف
Sit	جلس	اجلس
Lie down	استلقي	استلق
Eat	أكل	كل
Sleep	نام	نم
Play	لعب	العب

Wake up	إِسْتَيْقَظْ	إِسْتَيْقَظْ
Stop	تَوَفَّقَ	تَوَفَّقَ

Be quiet	كَانَ هادِئًا	كُنْ هادِئًا
Help me	سَاعَدَ verb only:	سَاعَدْ (help) سَاعَدْنِي (help me)
Jump	قَفَزَ	أَقْفَزْ
Don't jump	قَفَزَ	لَا تَقْفِزْ
Run	جَرَى	إِجْرِ
Don't run	جَرَى	لَا تَجْرِ
Wait	انتَظِرْ	إِنْتَظِرْ
Go out	خَرَجَ	أُخْرُجْ
Come in	دَخَلَ	أُدْخُلْ
Throw	رَمَى	إِرْمِ
Don't throw	لَا + رَمَى	لَا تَرْمِ
Don't scream	لَا + صَرَخَ	لَا تَصْرُخْ
Close	أَعْلَقَ	أَغْلِقْ
Close the door	أَعْلَقَ + الْبَابَ	*أَغْلِقْ الْبَابَ*

*** in this case, the ending "sukoun" of أَغْلِقْ becomes a "kesrah" to make the connection with the "lem" of the article before "باب"

Open	فَتَحَ	إِفْتَحْ
Open a window	فَتَحَ + نَافِذَةً	إِفْتَحْ نَافِذَةً
