English Commands (verbs in the imperative form or short sentences)	Arabic Infinitive Verbs (to search in the online conjugator)	Arabic Commands - with "YOU" singular, masculine (for other personal pronoun, check out our online conjugator tutorial)
Read	قَرَأَ	اقْرَأْ
Say	قَالَ	قُلْ
Be gentle/kind	كَانَ لَطِيفًا (in the conjugator, only search: كَانَ)	كُنْ لَطِيفًا ***
*** when conjugating, don't forget to change لَطِيفًا too! Example for a girl, you'll say: كوني لَطِيفَةً. This is also true for the following commands with the same structure.		
Walk	مَشَى	امْشِ
Stand up	وَقَفَ	قِفْ
Sit	جَلَسَ	اجْلِسْ
Lie down	اسْتَلْقَى	اسْتَلْقِ
Eat	أَكَلَ	كُلْ
Sleep	نَامَ	نِمْ
Play	لَعَبَ	الْعَبْ

Wake up	اِسْتَيْقِظْ	اِسْتَيْقِظْ
Stop	تَوَقَّفْ	تَوَقَّفْ

Be quiet	كَانَ هَادِئاً	كُنْ هَادِئاً
Help me	verb only: سَاعَدَ	سَاعِدْ (help) سَاعِدْنِي (help me)
Jump	قَفَزَ	اِقْفِزْ
Don't jump	قَفَزَ	لا تَقْفِزْ
Run	جَرَى	اِجْرِ
Don't run	جَرَى	لا تَجْرِ
Wait	اِنْتَظِرْ	اِنْتَظِرْ
Go out	خَرَجَ	اُخْرَجْ
Come in	دَخَلَ	اُدْخُلْ
Throw	رَمَى	اِرْمِ
Don't throw	لا + رَمَى	لا تَرْمِ
Don't scream	لا + صَرَخَ	لا تَصْرُخْ
Close	أَغْلَقَ	أَغْلِقْ
Close the door	أَغْلَقَ + البابَ	أَغْلِقِ البابَ ***
*** in this case, the ending "sukoun" of أَغْلِقْ becomes a "kesrah" to make the connection with the "lem" of the article before "باب"		
Open	فَتَحَ	اِفْتَحْ
Open a window	فَتَحَ + نافذةً	اِفْتَحْ نافذةً
