Important NOTE for parents/educators

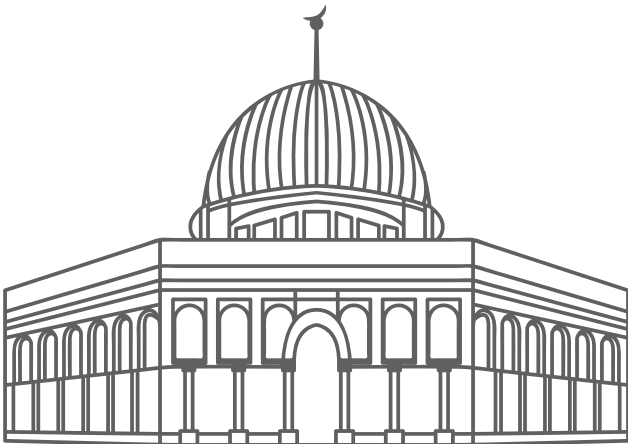
